# Upcoming Agenda 2030 Graduate School courses 2023:

- Representing sustainability (Faulty of Fine & Performing Arts, 7,5 ECTS). Time it will be given: 24 April 26 May 2023. This doctoral course will examine how narratives around the global goals are created, can be understood and also how it relates to the doctoral student's own research. You register by sending Henrik Rahm an e-mail (henrik.rahm@nordlund.lu.se) and deadline for registration is 3<sup>rd</sup> of April.
- Health and the environment with special focus on climate and sustainability (Faculty of Medicine, digital). Time to be given: 28 August 26 September 2023. This course aims to deliver knowledge and enhance understanding within the field of environmental epidemiology, with a focus on environmental health and relevant Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The course contains introduction to environmental medicine, climatology, climate modelling and climate change as well as in depth focus on themes concerning different health aspects, environment and climate, including heat and cold, air, water, built environment and lifestyles.
- Digital monies (School of Economics and Management). Time to be given: September October. This PhD course examines the technological developments that are facilitating monetary innovation and the role of monetary entrepreneurs in re-organizing the production and circulation of money. The course provides students with the tools to explore opportunities for addressing big societal challenges and asks in particular how new forms of money can contribute to developing more just and equal societies. Course coordinator: Ester Barinaga (<u>ester.barinaga@fek.lu.se</u>).
- A law to save the world? (Faculty of Law). Time to be given: November 2023 January 2024. This course offers critical analysis of the sustainable development goals and the discourses and interests they serve. Material from a range of disciplines history, politics, economics, and law is used for a better understanding of where Agenda 2030 is coming from and where the world it brings into being might be heading. The course focuses in particular on the relationship between sustainable development and our existing global legal order.
- Other courses to be given this fall are: Water and sustainable development (Faculty of Engineering) and Existential sustainability (Faculties of Humanities and Theology).

• **Recycling will not solve the plastic crisis** (21th April, 12:00-12:45), Botulfshörnan, Stadshallen, Stortoget 9, Lund. Recycling is often presented as one of the most important solutions to the plastic problem. But most plastics can only be recycled a few times, and the largest proportion of all plastics produced are never recycled. At the same time, global plastic use is increasing: today around 390 million tonnes of plastic are produced yearly.
